### **Biographical Note:**

Barbarian Press is a fine press publisher, owned and operated by Jan Elsted and Crispin Elsted in Mission, B.C., Canada. The press publishes in several main areas—literary classics, translations, typography, and books on wood engraving. Barbarian Press is an entirely letterpress shop with a collection of nine presses. This includes three 19th-century handpresses: the super royal Albion (1850), the foolscap folio Barrett Albion (1833), and the foolscap folio Sherwin & Cope Imperial (1854). They also have Vandercook Universal One and Universal III horizontal cylinder proof presses, a Red Ball Heidelberg Windmill, a 12 by 8 Craftsman press, and two Adana 8 by 5 tabletop presses. The press maintains a variety of typefaces, including favored text faces such as Bembo, Joanna, Poliphilus & Blado, Van Dijck, Monotype Garamond (156), ATF Garamond, Octavian, Walbaum, Bell, Pastonchi, and Cancelleresca Bastarda. The press also possesses a significant collection of titling and display faces, as well as type flowers and ornaments, including the complete Monotype ornament collection of the Curwen Press. The founders of Barbarian Press emphasize a relatively conservative style, stating, "Unlike those of many printers of fine books, our backgrounds are in literary studies and writing rather than graphic and studio arts, and we make our books to be read, not merely looked at." Simon Brett, (b.1943) in Windsor, was raised in London and received his education at Ampleforth College in Yorkshire. He developed his skills in wood engraving from Clifford Webb at Saint Martin's School of Art, London (1960-64). From 1961 onwards, Brett's wood engravings have been made as prints, bookplates, and primarily as illustrations for books. He is currently married to the painter Juliet Wood, and they reside in Marlborough, Wiltshire. In addition to his own daughter, Brett is the stepfather to three stepsons and a stepdaughter.

With Barbarian Press, Brett co-produced an edition of Shakespeare's *Pericles*. This edition aimed to vividly "stage the play on the page" through the inclusion of approximately 98 images on over 140 woodblocks. (Brett, 2023)

[N.B. The following blocks - from 52 to 57b - are listed according to the numbers Simon Brett wrote on the blocks themselves [q.v.]. However, unlike the blocks up to this point, which generally followed the order in which they appear in the book, the numbering of these next blocks does not follow the narrative order. This may be because SB numbered the blocks as they were engraved, or because we had not at the point when they were engraved decided the order in which we would use them. There are also 20 very small 'brothel advertisement' blocks used in this scene, unnumbered of which only 12 were used, with some repeated; these are printed in orange through five pages from #52a on, with 5 repeated on one page at a later point.]
