Scope and Content:

This accession of Afua Cooper's papers contains records related to writing and community involvement, material pertaining to her academic career as well as a small amount of personal papers. This includes writing drafts of poetry, articles and papers, project proposals, permissions and royalties for published books, as well as promotional material, such as flyers, posters, and programs, for community events, particularly those related to the African-Canadian community, that Cooper participated in or attended. The papers also contains some administrative records related to university professorship applications and letters of references, as well as programs, calls for papers and posters for academic conferences and lectures.
