Collection includes manuscript drafts, research notes, correspondence and photos relating to: Dr. Peter Charlebois' *The life of Louis Riel*. Toronto: New Canada Publications, 1975; the history of the Northwest Rebellion of 1885; and the history of Métis in Canada. Also includes several albums of riverboat photographs for his *Sternwheelers & Sidewheelers: the romance of steamdriven paddleboats in Canada*. Toronto: NC Press, 1978.

Dr. Charlebois worked as an Anaesthetist at Scarborough General Hospital, Scarborough, Ontario, and now lives in Penetang, Ontario. His research focused on the history of the Northwest Rebellion of 1885, and especially Louis Riel and other Métis participants. His great uncle was hung by the soldiers at Battleford, Saskatchewan in 1885. This collection is named in honour of Dr. Charlebois' great uncle and father.
