The chief part of the De la Roche correspondence and manuscripts were given to the University of Toronto Library by the author's cousin and literary executor, Miss Caroline Clement, in 1961 and 1962. Some correspondence with de la Roche's publishing firms (MacMillan, Little Brown) was given by John Gray, of Macmillan's in 1962. Additional de la Roche manuscript material came to the Library after Miss Clement's death in 1972.

The materials collected by Ronald Hambleton for his biography of Mazo de la Roche (Mazo de la Roche of Jalna. Toronto, 1966) were acquired from R. Hambleton, January 1968.

No restrictions placed on access to the manuscripts by either C. Clement or R. Hambleton.
