Two portraits of George Fetherling, described by himself:

"One is an encaustic painting by Gerhard Harpe of Kingston done in 1989 when I was there working for the "Whig". It's 13 x 10 inches, glazed and framed by the artist. Harpe, an immigrant from Germany, has been in Kingston many years and is quite a well known Ontario artist, showing frequently, both solo and in groups, and teaching. He's also a sculptor (one of his pieces is in the Toronto Sculptor Garden on King Street East, for example). Quarry Press published three books of his graphic art (three that I remember)."

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“The other picture is a 1985 portrait of me, sitting reading in the library/office at my former place at 247 Albany Avenue, with an Annex housescape in the background. It's gouache, 26 by 18 inches, glazed and framed by the artist, Dane Leming. Dane is a Toronto painter- (was a young one at the time-) who is also in demand as a gilder. There are plenty of his works around, but I believe this is the only portrait by him I've ever seen. You may recognise the style. (In fact you may have met him if you like to set foot in the art-auction community. His partner is Jack Kerr-Wilson, the former head auctioneer and appraiser at Phillips Ward-Price and, more recently, CEO of Bohams in Canada.)”
