Collection of lecture notes and miscellaneous material relating to the philosophy of Sankara, a seventh century Hindu philosopher. The lectures were originally contained in approximately fifty bound volumes, gathered together in a roughly chronological fashion. There are also loose lecture notes listed chronologically. Although the lectures were recorded by stenographers, there are several different type-faces used and it appears that several different people were responsible for their recording. The same lecture sometimes appears with different form and content. The lectures generally deal with Christian scripture and classical literature.

The lectures were delivered by Miss B.S.A. de Branconiére, also identified as 'Guru Sahasrara Satchitananda', to the student members of the Oriental Literature Society of California from 1906 to 1910. Miss de Branconiére is described as "an accredited Messenger from the Sankaracharya School of Philosophy, France" and she was also an honorary member of the Sankaracharya Association of Calcutta, India.

The collection also contains an Esoteric Dictionary which was compiled by Mary Elizabeth Gilmore in the mid- 1950s. The Dictionary contains definitions of philosophical and literary terms drawn from the lectures. Miss Gilmore also wrote several work books based on these lectures. It appears that Miss Gilmore gathered and arranged the lectures in their present form sometime in the mid-1930s.

A degree sign (°) indicates that the same version of the lecture appears in another volume. Any lecture date which is listed twice in the same volume, unless labeled 'a' (afternoon) or 'e' (evening) is a different version of the same lecture. Lectures which are simply repeated will have '2 copies' appear in the 'Notes' section.
