Gift of Johanna Katz

This accession consists largely of photographs, many of them signed, primarily of artists and writers. It also contains background material Katz collected on the various individuals represented in his Memento Books, including newspaper clippings and related correspondence. It also includes photographs of Henry Moore's work, material from the Arts & Letters Club of Toronto during the 1970s, and misc. professional material (photographs, correspondence, patents, printed matter) from Leon Katz's career as owner and president at Canada X-Ray Ltd. Personal material includes letters from Katz's parents written in the 1930s and a journal kept by Katz from 1958-1961. Additional correspondence includes holiday cards from friends, as well as letters from anonymous collectors solicited by Katz in advertisements in various magazines for a study he hoped to do on the psychology of collecting.

#### **Biographical sketch**

Leon Katz was born in Lvov, Austria (now Poland), in 1906. He moved to France with his parents before the First World War and graduated from the University of Toulouse with an engineering degree. In 1942, he fled to Spain after the Nazi invasion of France and spent three years in Barcelona. Katz emigrated to Canada in 1944 and got a job assembling resistors. In 1948, he developed and patented a flickerless fluorescent lamp, and the next year he founded his own company, Canadian Fluorescent Light Co., which eventually became Canada X-Ray Ltd. He was also president of the French Chamber of Commerce and art curator of the Alliance Francaise.

Katz's collecting history began in the early 1960s when he started collecting stamps, eventually accumulating around 10,000 in total. He then developed an interest in early Canadian books and Canadian art and became a serious collector. By the early 1970s, he began collecting autographs of artists, poets, composers and others, keeping them all in a leatherbound book he called "Mementos." It eventually ended up as two-volume book consisting of 341 paintings, sketches, prints, collages, autographs, partial music scores, poetry and prose collected by Katz, with the help of his wife Johanna, over nearly three decades, from 1970 to 1998.

Leon Katz died in 2000 at the age of 94.

#### **Arrangement note**

The bulk of this collection arrived in individual photo albums. In an attempt to preserve the provenance, not to mention the spirit, of this collection, the original ordering of the items has been maintained. As a result, each box represents the entire contents of a single album, with the ordering of the materials maintained. In other words, each folder represents one page of an album. (Photos have been removed and placed in archival

sleeves.) Titles given for each album by Katz have also been noted, along with a general description of the contents.

This collection also includes the Katz's Memento Books, which comes with its own Finding Aid.
