MACAULAY (THOMAS BABINGTON) PAPERS

A collection of eleven letters and notes written by Thomas Babington Macaulay, 1800-1859, between 1815 and 1858 to his family and friends. Six of the letters were published in Thomas Pinney's edition of Macaulay's letters in 1974. The earliest manuscript, two translations from Horace, shows Macaulay's early interest in Horace that continued throughout his life. The papers include one contemporary photograph of Macaulay, one photograph of his portrait in coloured chalk, and one engraving of him.
