Scope and Content:

Collection consists of two series. The first consists of 14 original works of art by Thoreau MacDonald and two original pencil drawings by J.E.H MacDonald donated by Leon Katz. The second series consists primarily of ephemera related to Thoreau MacDonald, which was donated by Ron Peters. This material is primarily composed of cards with his designs, order forms for books with his illustrations and other promotion material. Also included in the second series is research material used by Thoreau MacDonald related to hawks, predators and the environment.

The Thoreau MacDonald Collection of printed books and pamphlets is a separate special collection in the Fisher Library. It contains works written, and/or illustrated by Thoreau MacDonald, as well as books he published himself. The collection includes works which were in Thoreau MacDonald's own library and have been annotated by him. The major part of the collection of printed works was donated by Mrs. M.E. Edison.
