Biographical note:

Jack McLeod (1932-2016) was born in Regina, Saskatchewan. He earned a BA and MA in Economics from the University of Saskatchewan before taking a PhD in Political Science at the University of Toronto where he taught from 1959-1996.

He taught at the University of Toronto from 1959 – 1996 and after retirement, a course on Politics and the Media for senior students. An experience in Budapest during the Hungarian Revolution in 1956 began his career in political journalism. Articles appeared in *The Globe and Mail, The Toronto Star, Saturday Night, Maclean's, Canadian Forum, Books in Canada* and the *Journal of Canadian Studies*.

He was often a political commentator on CBC television and on radio. McLeod published academic works with the *University of Toronto Press*, *Oxford University Press* and *McLelland and Stewart* as well as two political science textbooks. He also coedited two books of political anecdotes with his wife Cynthia Smith for Oxford University Press. Aside from writing, he served on the board of the Toronto General Hospital from 1971-1978.

Writing fiction under the pseudonym of Jack MacLeod, he published three comic novels, two of which were best sellers and two were shortlisted for the Stephen Leacock Prize: Zinger and Me, Going Grand and Uproar. His commonplace book Reflections in My Wintertime was published (2015) by David Mason Books. A fourth novel, To Build a Better World was released posthumously at the end of 2016.
