HISTORICAL SKETCH

The Collected Edition of the works of John Stuart Mill, 1965-1990, volumes 1-31, was planned by an editorial committee appointed from the Faculty of Arts and Science of the University of Toronto and from the University of Toronto Press.

The main purpose, which is stated in each of the published volumes of the Edition, is "to present fully collated texts of those works which exist in a number of versions, both printed and manuscript, and to provide accurate texts of works previously unpublished or which have become relatively inaccessible".

John M. Robson, General and Textual Editor of the Collected Works of John Stuart Mill, is Professor of English at Victoria College, University of Toronto. He has written about major nineteenth century authors, including John and James Mill, as well as on the history of ideas, social history, journalism and textual editing.

The collection of papers consists of xerox copies of published works, manuscripts, typescripts, galleys, page proofs, drafts, text, notes, carbon copies, corrections, textual emendations, variants, offprints, and photographic reproductions of materials. Some of the material is on tapes, which are not included in the collection. Correspondence in the collection mainly relates to the editing of the works.

"The general policy in these volumes, as throughout the edition, is to adopt as the basic text the latest version from Mill's own pen. Earlier versions, and those in which he may have had a hand (though published after his death), are collated with the basic text, and the resulting substantive variants are given as footnotes".

The collection also contains essays first published in journals and newspapers, as well as the 'Fabian typescripts' of Mill's speeches. The Fabian Society typescripts are copies of Mill manuscripts owned by Harold Laski and made by him for the Society which planned to publish them. It did not publish them but Laski later published some of them in journals that are noted on the carbon copies. Later Professor Ney MacMinn who bought the carbon copies from the Fabian Society gave them to the editor when the Mill Project began.

The earlier and later letters of John Stuart Mill, comprising volumes 12-17, edited by Francis E. Mineka, Cornell University, are not included in this collection.

Box 112, which has Mill manuscripts, contains a speech and six letters from Mill. They supplement other Mill manuscripts in the Fisher Library: MSS 3074 Speech on the Character of Catiline, delivered at the London Debating Society, Tuesday, 28th February, 1826, and holograph notes.
