NEEDLER, George Henry, 1866-1962

Dates: 1821-1947

Bio: George Needler was a professor of German.

Collection consists of *John Galt's Poems*, edited by Needler; notes on and correspondence concerning Anna Jameson; notes on and copies of letters from Catherine Elizabeth (Browne) Kirkpatrick and Harriet Beaufort, labelled "Otanabee pioneers"; notes and correspondence regarding Galt and Scott; letters from David Macbeth Moir to Alexander Balfour.
