Collection is comprised exclusively of correspondence, including photographs and drawings from various friends and associates of Charles Pachter, many of whom are prominent Canadians. The collection contains personal and business material from the 1950s to 2001. The correspondence reflects Pachter's extensive and changeable career as an artist, including material from all of his exhibitions; for the retrospective of his work, *Charles Pachter* by Bogomila Welsh-Ovcharov; his close relationship with his mother and father ("Dibbles and Har") and his large circle of friends, fans and acquaintances. Pachter studied art at the Sorbonne in Paris, the Cranbrook Academy of Art in Michigan and the University of Toronto. His involvement in graphic art production; paper-making; real estate; building renovation and Gracie's, his Queen Street West restaurant in Toronto are all documented here. The collection also includes material related to his work as writer, lecturer, informal Canadian historian, and his extensive charitable pursuits.

Chronology:

1942 December 30, born in downtown Toronto at 499 Palmerston Boulevard, the second of four children to Harry and Sara Pachter.

1946-50 Family moves uptown to 84 Chudleigh Avenue. Attends John Ross Robertson public school and Holy Blossom Temple. Spends summers at various cottages around southern Lake Simcoe.

1947 Stars in *Johnny at the Fair*, a National Film Board documentary about the Canadian National Exhibition. Meets Prime Minister Mackenzie King, gets kissed by Barbara Ann Scott, pets a moose.

1950-55 Family moves to 83 Ava Road. Attends John R. Wilcox public school. Studies piano with Rachel Cavalho, painting with Ronald Satok.

1955-60 Attends Vaughan Road Collegiate. Takes academic art course under Miss Hudgins.

1957 Paints large mural on his bedroom wall of the Canadian landscape on the \$2 bill.

1958 Dr. Verna Curran encourages his French studies. Goes on a *visite interprovinciale* exchange program hosted by a family in east Montreal. Sees Quebec City. Paints sets for musical shows at Camp Katonim, Lake Simcoe. Discovers the unused attic of the family house, creates a private space where he works and paints for two years.

1959 Attends an Arts Festival in Great Barrington, Mass. Paints landscape in oil, builds a portable ark for Holy Blossom Temple school. Invited to Saturday morning classes for gifted adolescents at the Art Gallery of Toronto, supervised by William Withrow. Chosen Simpson's representative for Vaughan Road Collegiate. Paints a wall mural of a prairie road for the Home Furnishings department; models for Simpson's Catalogue.

1959-64 Summers, teaches arts and crafts and drama at Camp White Pine, Haliburton, Ontario. Creates special events programming. Meets and befriends Margaret Atwood, head of the nature program.

1960-62 Heads the arts and crafts department at Holy Blossom Temple school. Enrols in Art and Archaeology at University of Toronto, taught by Steven Vickers, Robert Welsh, Scott Symons, Ted Bieler. Fellow classmates include Bogomila Ovcharov and Douglas Richardson.

1961 Takes night courses in silkscreening under Fred Hagan at Ontario College of Art. Sketches with Ed Roman in the Rouge River Valley. Paints watercolours and oils of landscapes.

1962-63 Studies at the Sorbonne in Paris, travels around France, Spain, Italy, and Corsica. Makes figure drawings and watercolours at the Académie de la Grande Chaumière, streetscapes in and around Paris.

1963-64 Returns to Canada, completes Honours BA at University of Toronto. Visits Chicago to see houses of Frank Lloyd Wright. Makes silkscreens at Camp White Pine and in studio in Mirvish Village on Markham Street. Makes large oil painting of Toronto house, *Reminiscences of a Euclid Avenue House*, and *Horseforms*. February – first solo exhibition of serigraphs at Pollock Gallery on Markham Street. *Birds in Flight, Family, St. Lawrence Market, Face*.

1964-66 Attends Michigan's Cranbrook Academy of Art. Studies papermaking, lithography, silkscreen, etching, painting, design. Corresponds with Margaret Atwood studying at Harvard. Prints five limited edition illustrated folios of her poetry. Produces lithographs *Prism, Who is Sylvia?, Couple, The Myth, Two Plus One*. Paints first realistic satirical work, *The Hiya Dolls*. Visits Mexico, Cuernavaca, Tepotzlan.

1966 Graduates with an MFA from Cranbrook, returns to Toronto. Sets up a printing studio, rents rooms to friends. Prints lithographs *The Winner, Funny What Love Can Do, Golem, Conflux*. Acquires fonts of old foundry type. Makes handmade book of lithographs, *Notebook Pages*, illustrating the poems of John Newlove. Joins Quadrat society of private press printers at Massey College.

1967 Moves to Montreal. Lives across from Park Lafontaine, works in the theme division of Expo '67, installs sculptures for the *Exposition Internationale*. Meets Alexander Calder, prints lithographs *Masque, Body Politic*, in the Atelier Graff of Pierre Ayot, Rue Rachel. Musée d'Art Contemporain buys first Atwood-Pachter portfolio, *The Circle Game*. Limited edition books purchased by dealers Joseph Amtmann and Laurie Lerew.

1968 Returns to Toronto. Buys first house at 1232 Shaw Street. Build a separate printing studio. Makes lithographs *It's Just a Flesh Wound, Champêtre, Invocation, Is the Pope Catholic?*, handmade book of poems by Alden Nowlan, *A Black Plastic Button and a Yellow Yoyo*. March – exhibits lithographs at Gallery Pascal, 104 Yorkville Avenue, Toronto. Visits France, Greek islands, begins psychotherapy.

1969-70 Invited by Dean Richard Johnston to teach at the University of Calgary. Lives in a small frame house on 21st Avenue South West. Makes silkscreens *Elegy for Bluebeard, Lookout*; lithographs *Model Modern Message, She'll Be Comin' Round the Mountain, Happy Trails to You, O Bury Me Not, Beautiful Revelation, Plunge Deluge*. Works with John K. Esler, Anthony Benjamin, Alexandra Haeseker. February – exhibits new graphics at Canadian Art Galleries, Calgary.

1970 April – returns to Toronto. Begins first renovation project, guts and rebuilds house and studio at 1232 Shaw Street. October - second exhibition of graphics at Gallery Pascal.

1971 Makes several editions of streetcar serigraphs. December – tours the Middle East, returns to Canada, flies to Cape Dorset, North West Territories to teach lithography to the Inuit. Takes ill, is flown south.

1972-73 January-February, recuperates at Toronto Western Hospital. April – exhibits streetcar graphics at Isaacs Gallery. Sets type, illustrates Dennis Lee's book of children's poems, *Wiggle to the Laundromat*. July – visits the Gaspé coast. Returns to Toronto, begins series of paintings exploring the monarchy in Canada. *Procession Through Landscape, Noblesse Oblige, The Visitation, Double Bubble, Rite de Passage, Clair de Lune, The Curtsy Triptych, Snow Queen*. Parts with Isaacs Gallery.

1973 June – creates the first of many Toronto “event” opening parties, The Other Shaw Festival, for the exhibition of new paintings, *Monarchs of the North*, at his studio at 1232 Shaw Street, which coincides with the queen's visit to the Shaw Festival in Niagara-on-the-Lake. Buys old factory at 24 Ryerson Avenue near Queen and Bathurst Streets. Continues painting and printing landscapes, moose, rocks, goats, Canadian Tire collages. *Flight of the Toaster, Mooseponder, Lakemark*.

1974 August – moves to 24 Ryerson Avenue. Founds Artists Alliance Building Limited. Starts artists' co-op gallery called Artery. Moves to top-floor loft where he lives and works for two years. Discovers derelict factory next door, which he helps director Paul Thompson purchase for Theatre Passe Muraille. Buys and renovates neighbouring warehouse buildings as extensions of Artists Alliance. October – holds huge event party to mark the opening of the Artery. Coincides with opening party of Stage II, new wing of Art Gallery of Ontario.

1975 February – exhibits *Landmarks* at Artery: paintings, *Look Out Barbara Ann, Kippawa*; prints and collages, *Mooseponder, Moosamour*. Chairs an Art Gallery of Ontario citizens' committee advocating wider community participation on the gallery's board of trustees. Conceives two “performance art” group shows exploring taste – The Ugly Show and The Stunning Show.

1976 Moves to and restores large Victorian house at 350 Markham Street. Forms Pungent Productions, renovation company with John Stewart and John Eckler. Paints large work *Life Is Not A Fountain*, silkscreens *Mooseplunge*. Joins Artists With their Work program at the Art Gallery of Ontario. Lectures and shows in Kingston, Ottawa, Owen Sound, Simcoe, Hamilton, Sudbury. June – buys 100-acre farm in Oro township near Orillia. House of Anansi Press publishes *The Queen of Canada Colouring Book* with Pachter drawings.

1977 August – purchases derelict grocery store and blacksmith's shop near Grange Park. Renovates it into a permanent home and studio. October – Collins Pachter Tinkl exhibition opens at AGO.

1978 Paints ink and dry brush portraits of friends, Figures in a Landscape paintings from Oro, Lake Simcoe. Visits Paris for Michael Snow exhibition at the Pompidou Centre. Draws portraits – *David Earle, Peter Randazzo, Joyce Wieland, Catherine Williams, John Hirsch, Peter Newman, Rick Salutin, Susan Swan, Margaret Atwood*. Renovates 78 Sullivan Street for Lester & Orpen Dennys.

1979 Figures in a Landscape opens at *Soho Loft Gallery*, 367 Queen Street West. *Six Figures in a Landscape, Self Portrait on Couch, A Pause on the French River, Convertible in a Landscape, Monika at Oro*; portraits *Alix Arnett, Gwendolyn MacEwen, Wendy Weaver, Michael Snow*.

1980 Purchases Remeny House of Music Building at 553 Queen Street West, opens Ring Gallery, hires director Judith Saunders. Resumes work on Margaret Atwood's *The Journals of Susanna Moodie*. With ten partners renovates a furniture store at 508 Queen Street West into Gracie's restaurant. October – exhibits *The Journals of Susanna Moodie* and new portraits at Ring Gallery. Begins renovation of former IGA supermarket and building at 567 Queen Street West. November – gala opening of Gracie's.

1981 Invited to exhibit in Artists in Books, at the National Library, Ottawa. June – starts series of large flag paintings. November – opening of the exhibition *The Painted Flag* in the new IGA Gallery.

1982 Recession. Gracie's closes. IGA Gallery closes. Artists Alliance closes. Business partnerships end. All real estate holdings are sold except house and studio. Invited to show in *Post-Pop Realism, The Winnipeg Perspective*, Winnipeg Art Gallery.

1983 Three large flag paintings are acquired by Olympia & York.

1984 Sees exhibition *The Mystic North* at AGO. Makes paintings of loyalists, historical and contemporary figures, an objects in "Group of Seven" landscape settings. *Simcoe's Reward, Cold Comfort, Davenport and Bay, lake, Couch, I Ching, Queen's Rangers, Castle Frank in Winter*. March-July, exhibits paintings and graphics at Mövenpick Restaurant gallery. July – *The Journals of Susanna Moodie* opens at the Art Gallery of Ontario. November – invited to show in the group exhibition *Vestiges of Empire* in London, England. December – one-man exhibition of new paintings, *Waterworks*, opens at Queen's Quay Terminal, Toronto.

1985-86 April-October, *Regarding the Flag*, exhibition of twenty flag paintings at the Ontario Science Centre, Toronto, celebrating the flag's twentieth anniversary. September – exhibits *Waterworks* at The Arts and Letters Club, Toronto. November – tours Tokyo, Kyoto, Taiwan, Bangkok, Singapore, Macau, Hong Kong. New paintings *The Supremes, Float, Bare in Mind the Light, State of the Tarts, To All In Tents*. December – *Bequia* in the Grenadines. Paints *Gait, Arcade, Revelation*. Begins series of fifty line-drawing portraits of prominent Canadians for *City and Country Home* magazine.

1986 April – exhibits new paintings at Gallery Moos. *Rapprochement, The Supremes, Mooseplunge, Float, Discovery: The Canvas House, Sealed Off, Constitutional*. July – purchases and renovates 80 Beverley Street, across from the Art Galley of Ontario.

1987 January – exhibits works at opening of the new Alliance Française. *Tour de Force, To All In Tents, Une Demoiselle de Toronto, Oro Barn, Cipher*. February – documentary profile *Pachter*, directed by Claude Grenier, National Film Board, Montreal. April – exhibits at Ryerson Polytechnical Institute, Toronto. Writes series of articles on art and architecture for *The Toronto Star*.

1988 Makes Amiga computer-generated sketches for paintings. *Red Barn at Oro, Red Barn Reflected*. Starts diary. November – exhibits large paintings at La Citadelle, Montreal. *State of the Tarts, A Cross the Lake, Ann at Oro, Moose Stall, Catherine Williams, Life Is not a Fountain, To All In Tents*.

1989 February – paints large acrylic commissioned portraits of Bogomila and Robert Welsh, Marilyn Lightstone and Moses Znaimer, Eva and Edward Borins, Pauline Elias. Paints *Sir Who, Moose Lake, Flaspatter, Buy Lingual, Oro Barns Seen From My Window*. December – visits Greece: Delphi, Athens, Paros.

1990 April – exhibits new works at Castle Hill. *Ari Air View, Ordinary Canadians, The Once and Future King, The Rosedale Kiss, Night Ride, Black Lit Clark, Sealed Off, Round Square*. July – paints mural *Voice of Culture* on exterior wall of Acme Bar and Grill, King and John streets, Toronto. August – visits the south of France. September – paints three portraits of Pierre Trudeau, two portraits of Van Gogh as a young man. *A la recherche du jeune Vincent, Vincent au lit*.

1991 Solo exhibitions at The Summit, Canada Trust in Toronto, and at Inniskillin Winery, Niagara-on-the-Lake. October – First European retrospective at the Centre d'Art Présence Van Gogh, Saint-Rémy-de-Provence, France.

1992 April – Retrospective exhibition opens at the Haus an der Redoute gallery in Bonn, Germany.
