Collection of correspondence and papers relating to Dr. Norman Bethune including papers from the files of Ted Allan, a biographer of Bethune, and research notes of Alvin and Darley Gordon for a proposed Twentieth Century-Fox feature film on the life of Bethune. Allan's correspondence with Dr. John B. Barnwell (1895-1966) a friend of Bethune from their time as patients at Trudeau Sanitorium in Saranac Lake in 1926 is a part of Allan's files.
