VAN DER SMISSEN FAMILY PAPERS

The correspondence includes letters to Jacob Gysbert van der Smissen from Johann Lavater (1741-1800), a Reformed minister in Zurich influential through his writings, sermons, and correspondence from Johann Heinrich Jung-Stilling (1740-1817), an eminent theological writer, and from Carl Heinrich von Bogatzky (1690-1774) an influential and prolific Lutheran writer in Germany. Family correspondence contains letters to Elisabeth van der Smissen; to Louise, her sister; and to Henry van der Smissen who married Louise. Other papers are a biography of Helena Linnich; a family history; the sermons of Wilhelm Leendert; the account by Gilbert van der Smissen of his travels in Europe and the marriage address to Henry and Louise by Henry, Louise's father. Henry van der Smissen emigrated to Canada in 1833. In 1838 he returned to Germany to marry his cousin, Louise, whom he brought to Canada along with her sister Elisabeth.
