

DOUGLAS FAMILY PAPERS, 1888-1945

A small collection of letters, photos, commonplace books and memorabilia, given by Mr. Wm. H. Douglas, 19 Roxborough St. E. Toronto. The material chiefly relates to the Hughes family of St. Thomas, Ont. (See notes on manuscripts file for family notes.) No restrictions on use.

1. Eleanor Hughes. Recipe book. 1888?
2. Susie Hughes. Notebook. "English literature. British poets". Actually a commonplace book of a religious nature.
3. Susie Hughes. Small commonplace book, chiefly religious in tone. Given to Susie Hughes, October 13, 1872. 1st two pages in another hand.
4. Susie Barwick Hughes Douglas. Sarnia. Personal accounts, 1891-1916.
(Originally a pass book for the Traders' Bank of Canada.)
5. Collection of bills and receipts for purchases, March-April, 1888, apparently Miss Susie Hughes' trousseau, before marriage to J.C. Douglas.
6. Telegrams congratulating Mr. & Mrs. J.C. Douglas, May 1888.
7. 2 A.L.S. from John A Kains to Edie [Edith Hughes]. April-May, 1864. On scenic note-paper, one depicting Toronto in mid century (tinted) and one of the University of Toronto [i.e. University College]
8. Three French poems, probably copied by Susie Hughes.
9. Deed to cemetery plot, Lakeview Cemetery, Sarnia, Ont. John Cameron Douglas.
10. 2 family photos.
